The Concours venue is located on the Parade Grounds of the former Alameda Naval Air Station 950 West Mall Square, Alameda (Alameda Point) close to where the famous aircraft carrier USS HORNET is docked.

The Alameda Point Concours d'Elegance is celebrating the Rock 'n' Roll Era by featuring American made cars of the '50s and '60s with coupes, convertibles, station wagons, pickups and muscle cars.

A host of other classes will join these important cars that include: American Sports Cars, Pre and Post War, Imported Sports and Passenger Cars, Preservation Class, Rolls-Royce/Bentley, Ferrari, Period Hot Rods, Exotics, Race Cars, Motorcycles, Cars of Alameda, Vintage Travel Trailers and Special Displays.

New classes for 2018 include: GenXcellent Cars (Cars of the '80s and 90s), and Electric Propulsion.

The Concours d'Elegance is an SCCA sanctioned event. Judging and scoring will be as defined on the Classes List. Entries will be judged on interior, exterior, engine and chassis based on authenticity, general appearance, care and preparation. Only stock un-modified cars will be accepted for judging.

REGISTRATION-To request consideration for your vehicle to be entered in the Concours d'Elegance, please fill out the application, attach your 3 photos, "one needs to be the exterior, interior and engine compartment" along with the fee Early Bird of \$80.00 by March 12 after March 13 \$100.00. No refunds will be given.

PATRON'S PAVILION tickets are available for you to enjoy a Champagne Continental Breakfast and a Buffet Lunch with wine, beer, soft drinks and water catered by **Herbs and Spices Catering**. The Patron's Pavilion has the best view for watching the Special Exhibits and Trophy Presentation.

THE DRIVE on Saturday June 9 starts at 8:00 AM at the Concours d'Elegance Field with coffee, donuts, and photo shoots, followed by an Alameda Police Department Motorcycle escorted drive through the back country to the Blackhawk Automobile Museum for a Docent tour (parking on the Blackhawk Museum Plaza-limited spots) and then driving through the Canyons ending for lunch at Twining Vine Winery in Castro Valley. Tickets are available for driver and passengers.

THE SPECTATOR fee is \$20 per person with this entry form or online and \$25.00 at the gate. Children 16 and under free and must be accompanied by a paying adult.

Free parking for spectators will be available on all streets adjacent to the Concours field.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Concours Selection Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry for judging that does not meet Concours Standards. Each class will be limited to 10 judged entries and limited to 12 total entries. The Selection Committee has the right to change the entries classification or change, add or combine classes depending on the number and type of entries.

Vehicles competing to win the SCCA Year End Championship award must be 1987 or older. Once a car has won this award, it is ineligible to win again.

No Transporters or Vehicle Trailers shall be permitted on the Concours d'Elegance fields. Transporter parking will be available on the streets adjacent to the Concours fields.

All Vehicles must be driven through registration. No trailer unloading will be allowed on the Concours d'Elegance fields.

Placement of cars, motorcycles and vintage travel trailers on the fields will be between 7:00 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. on Show day. If you are planning on bringing and leaving your vehicle on Saturday night, please let us know. There will be Alameda Police Department Security on site Saturday night.

Commercial signs, displays, for sale signs, drones, dogs (with the exception of certified service dogs), will be prohibited on the Concours field. Personal pop-up tents or umbrellas are strictly prohibited. ***All Trailers and Vehicles must have fully charged FIRE EXTINGUISHERS!***

Please set up your chairs behind your automobile, not in front.

JUDGING AND SCORING

Any entrant may choose to have his or her car judged or entered as exhibit only. Exhibit only entries may not be changed to Judged on the day of the show.

Class Judging will begin at 10:00 a.m. Awards presentation will begin at approximately 2:00 p.m. Exhibitors must be at their car during judging. Judging score sheets will not be given.

Entrants are advised to check their cars between 1:30 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to see if they have received a card on their windshield stating they have won an award and should remain at their car until directed to drive to the trophy presentation area.
